

FMCSA & Wisconsin CDL Waivers

1. CDL/CLP Licenses have been extended until 08/31/2021:

CDL's and CLP's that expired on or after March 12, 2020, have been extended through August 31, 2021.

Note: This extension notation will appear on the status checker at the top of the page. Please use this tool to check the status of customers whose CLP has expired. Wisconsin Department of Transportation Check your driver license information

2. School Bus Abbreviated Testing Requirement has ended 5/31/2021:

- WI DMV has previously paused the cancellation of the 'S' endorsement due to failure to complete the Abbreviated School Bus exam that was due on or after March 1, 2020. These exams are normally due at renewal for 'S' endorsement holders and every 2 years for 'S' endorsement holders age 70 and older.
- All school bus drivers that have used the waiver and are due for testing will be notified via Department letter of Abbreviated School Bus testing requirements. MRF will be mailing letters to all impacted drivers the week of June 7th. They will have 60 days to complete the testing.

3. Medical Certification Requirement Extension Notice, please read carefully:

For CDL holders, CLP holders, and non-CDL drivers whose medical certification expired on or after March 1, 2021, the requirement under 49 CFR 391.45 is waived until August 31, 2021.

The customers record will still display as "not medically certified", but the license will remain valid during this public health emergency. Affected drivers will be notified in advance of medical filing requirements.

4. 14 Day Wait Waiver has been extended until 08/31/2021:

WI DMV will continue to waive the normal 14 days a customer must wait to take a CDL skills test after obtaining a Commercial Learners Permit. The customers will still need to wait the 2 day wait time after being scheduled by their examiner but then is eligible to take the CDL skills exam.
